

POLICE & NURSES PRIMARY SCHOOLS COLOURING IN COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Information on how to enter the Primary Schools Colouring in Competition and associated prize draw form part of these Conditions of Entry. Participation in this Competition constitutes acceptance of these Conditions of Entry.
2. The promoter is Police & Nurses Credit Society Ltd (PNCS), ABN 69 087 651 876, Level 7, 130 Stirling Street, Perth, WA.
3. Entry is open to all children aged 3years to 12 years old who attend primary school in Western Australia (*only one entry per person*). Family members of PNCS employees are ineligible to enter.
4. To enter the Competition, (unless the entrant has advised PNCS that he or she does not wish to enter the prize draw element) the entrant must complete and lodge at a Police & Nurses branch a colouring in sheet by 5pm Friday 16 April 2010.
